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The North Country Trail stretches for 4,600 miles through 7 states, from New York to North Dakota. It is the longest of our nation's scenic hiking trails. It is managed by the National Park service. Michigan contains more miles of this trail than any other state. The Harbor Springs Chapter of the North Country Trail Association maintains 46 miles of the trail, from the Mackinac Bridge south.
