Trail Guide

(Kipp Road Trailhead to Mackinaw City)

Maps

To get a digital map of any portion of the North Country Trail, download the Avenza App (free), and then go to https://northcountrytrail.org/the-trail/trail-map-and-downloads/#mobile and download the maps you wish to use. There is no charge. For a map of the Harbor Springs Chapter segment of the trail, download the Brochure/Map at www.northcountrytrail.org/hrb. Copies of the Harbor Springs Chapter Brochure/Map are also available at most trailheads.

Camping - General Information

Facilities for camping along the North Country Trail vary greatly. In Emmet County camping is permitted on the North Country Trail with these provisions:

- •Campsite must be on public land
- •No camping along road walks.
- •Campsite must not be within a mile of a designated campground
- •No camping in Wilderness State Park, except at designated camp sites. Part of Section 6, all of Sections 7 and 8, and part of section 9 are in Wilderness State Park.
 - Campsite must not be adjacent to a rail-trail
- •Campers must fill out and post a campsite registration card (Make up your own registration card if you don't have a pre-printed one)

Camping in Sections 1-5 (Kipp Road to Levering Road, south to north) Camping is allowed along most of this part of the trail which is on state land. There are exceptions.

No Camping in Section 5-A (Beckon Road to Dzedzie-Division Roads) This section of the trail goes through the BlissFest Property. No camping, fires, or exploring on this property. Continued permission to cross this beautiful property depends on hikers following these requests.

Camping In Sections 6-11 (Wycamp Dam to Mackinaw City, south to north) The area around Wycamp Dam has three owners. Emmet County owns 2.5 acres right around the dam, and including the dam. Not far from the dam is where Wilderness State Park begins; a sign on the trail shows where it begins/ends. The rest of the land is DNR. So camping is ok, but not on the Wilderness State Park land. Right along Wycamp Creek is either Emmet County or DNR land.

Camping is limited on the part of the trail which goes through Wilderness State Park. The Park allows camping only in designated camping areas, registration for camping, and payment of fees for camping. Almost 16 miles of the trail goes through Wilderness

State Park, from Wycamp Dam to about a mile past East Boundary Trail, Wilderness Park intersection #14. Signs on the trail indicate when entering/leaving the park.

There are only two places to camp within Wilderness State Park—the main campground area just north of the Section 9 Trailhead (directions at the Trailhead) and a primitive camp site along the trail east of the East Boundary Trail, Wilderness Park intersection #14, with registration and payment.

There are more camping areas at French Farm Lake, about two miles east of French Farm Lake Dam, which are operated by the DNR, with self registration and no payment, but camping only in the designated areas. They are first come, first served, 8 camping sites.

Water Sources (hiking south to north)

Most of the water sources are marked on the Harbor Springs Chapter Brochure/Map.

There is a stream at about a mile north of Brutus Road on Section 2 and an outside water faucet on the north side of the Pleasantview Town Hall on Pleasantview Road. The next water source is water stashed by a Harbor Springs Chapter volunteer. It's located about forty yards south of Robinson Road on the right edge of the trail.

On Section 5A, between Beckon and Dzedzie Roads, the trail goes through the BlissFest property, marked with carsonite posts with NCT stickers, no tree blazes. There are two water sources on the BlissFest Property, a drinkable faucet on the right edge of the trail approximately .4 mile north of Beckon Road. The other is located at .8 mile north of Beckon Road. However, these water faucets are turned off during winter and turned on from May to October. No camping or exploring along the Blissfest property—please stay on the trail.

Next water source is Wycamp Lake, visible when crossing Abrams Road the second time, about one and one-third miles north of the Section 6 Trailhead. The next water source is at Wycamp Dam. Lake Michigan is available at Lakeview Road, the Section 8 Trailhead. Next is a creek one mile north of the Section 8 Trailhead.

The next water source is in Wilderness State Park campground area, just beyond the Section 9 Trailhead (directions at the trailhead). There is water at Carp River, after crossing Cecil Bay Road (Section 10 Trailhead). Two miles from the Section 10 Trailhead the trail crosses French Farm Lake Dam and follows the French Farm Lake shoreline for about 2 miles. The last section of trail crosses a pipeline and then follows the Northwest State Trail to the Mackinaw City trailhead where there are water and restrooms available in summer.

- Section 1 Kipp Road Good parking
- Section 1 Accessible at Valley Road with good parking lot
- Section 2 Brutus Road Good parking
- Section 3 Stutsmanville Road Widened road parking
- Section 4 Larks Lake Road Widened road parking
- Section 4 Accessible at Middle Village Road
- Section 5 Robinson Road. No parking area. Park .2 mile west at the intersection of the seasonal Gregory Road. Good parking at the end of Section 5 at Van Road-Blackberry Trail.
- Section 6 Limited parking on the side of Zmikly Road. Much of Section 6 can be accessed along Spirit Lake Road (formerly Wycamp Lake Road).
- Section 7 Widened road parking
- Section 8 Good parking lot, but requires State Park Passport Permit
- Section 9 Wilderness State Park parking lot Passport Permit required
- Section 10 Limited parking along Cecil Bay Road
- Section 11 Limited widened road parking. Good parking lot at the north end of Section 11, the Mackinaw City Trailhead.

Emmet County Headlands Park

The French Farm Lake area borders Emmet County Headlands. The park is 550 acres of pristine woodlands, with more than two miles of undeveloped Lake Michigan shoreline and is home to many species of rare and endangered plants. It is also home to an International Dark Sky Park.

Access the park by leaving the NCT at the north end of French Farm Lake (trailhead 11). Follow French Farm Lake Road (dirt road) one mile to the corner of Wilderness Park Drive and Trailsend Road. Follow Wilderness Park Drive (paved) one mile north to the entrance of Headlands Park.

The Park has many groomed trails for hiking, biking, snowshoeing, and skiing. A map at the entrance gazebo shows marked trails.

Crossing the Mackinac Bridge

From the Mackinaw City Trailhead, follow the North Country Trail south to Nicolet Street (short distance). Follow Nicolet Street north about 1 1/2 blocks, going past the traffic light. Just past the road entry to the Mackinaw Bridge is a booth with a direct phone to the Mackinac Bridge Authority. Call for transportation across the bridge. Or call 906-643-7600. Currently transportation over the Mackinac Bridge costs \$5 per person and is available 24/7.

Hiking Petoskey - Mackinaw City

(Hiking north from Petoskey)

Beginning at Petoskey - For at great beginning start at Riverbend Park (Standish Avenue-S. Howard Road) for a beautiful hike along the Bear River. The trail is partly paved. Note that there is an easily missed, sharp turn past Bridge Street where the trail goes down cement steps, across a small stream, and then crosses a bridge over the Bear River and proceeds along the opposite bank, to Bayfront Park. (The turn is obvious when hiking north to south.)

At Bayfront Park the trail follows the Little Traverse Wheelway to Spring Lake Park and from there the trail follows the Northwestern State Trail (paved) to North Conway Road. There is a short road walk along North Conway Road and then the trail goes into the woods. This part of the trail is maintained by the Jordan 45 Chapter.


The section of the trail maintained by the Harbor Springs Chapter extends from Kipp Road to Mackinaw City. The Harbor Springs Chapter Brochure (with a map) applies only to the trail from Kipp Road to Mackinaw City.

Wilderness State Park

The south boundary of Wilderness State Park is near Wycamp Dam. The trail from Wycamp Dam to Sturgeon Bay Trail is not shown on the Wilderness State Park Trails map. Wilderness State Park trails are named and marked by intersections. "NCT" indicates a North Country Trail which does not follow a Wilderness State Park Trail. Hiking south to north in Wilderness Park, you will encounter the parks's intersection numbers 23, 22, 21, 19, 20, 3, 10, 11, 12, and 14.

Wilderness State Park Trails Rules

- 1. Camp only in designated camping areas—reserve, register, pay camping fee (Only camp sites are circled in red; No camping elsewhere)
- 2. No ground fires

Trail Sections

Section #11 - 2.7 Miles

Mackinaw City - north end of French Farm Lake

Directions

The trailhead is located on French Lake Road one half mile south of Trails End Road.

Description

The trail includes views of French Farm Lake, contains many puncheon walkways and goes through hardwoods and pine forests. Part of the trail follows the Northwestern State Trail and is paved between Trails End Road and Mackinaw City. It also crosses a gas and oil pipeline.

Recommended activities

Hiking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing

Section #10 - 5.12 Miles

Cecil Bay Road northeast to the north end of French Farm Lake

Directions

The trailhead is located at 12168 Cecil Bay Road one eighth mile north of Oliver Road.

Description

The trail includes balsam, cedar and pine forests. It crosses Carp River and French Farm Lake dam. It includes many puncheon walkways over streams and wet areas. Two miles of the trail border French Farm Lake with many scenic views and waterfowl viewing in summer.

Recommended activities

Hiking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing

Section #9 - 5.2 Miles

Swamp Line Trail through

Wilderness State Park to Cecil Bay Road

Directions

The trailhead is on Swampline Road near Canada Goose Pond within Wilderness State Park. A State Park Passport Permit is required for parking.

Description

Much of this pine forest trail follows Wilderness Park Trails, including Swampline, Nebo, East Ridge, and Red Pine. It crosses East Boundary Trail. Note that Wilderness Park marks their trail intersections. Park rules apply when hiking Park trails. Signs mark when entering/leaving the Park.

Recommended activities

Hiking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing

Sturgeon Bay Trail - There are two Sturgeon Bay Trails. One is a county road which goes between Pleasantview Road and Lakeshore Road. The other is a trail within Wilderness State Park.

Section #8 - 6.5 Miles

West Lakeview picnic area north to Canada Goose Pond in Wilderness Park (6.5 miles)

Directions

The trailhead is east of the corner of 10498 North Lakeshore Drive and West Lakeview Road in the "picnic area" parking lot. Park Passport Permit is required for parking.

Description

About half of this trail follows Wilderness Park Trails, Swampline and Sturgeon Bay Trail. Wilderness Park marks trail intersections. The other half goes through pine and hardwood forests, a swamp, through Lake Michigan sand dunes and along many ponds. All of this section is within Wilderness State Park, and Park rules apply.

Recommended activities

Hiking and snowshoe

Section #7 - 2.8 Miles

Sturgeon Bay Trail north to West Lake Shore Road

Directions

The Sturgeon Bay trailhead is two tenths of a mile east of the corner of West Sturgeon Bay Trail and North Lakeshore Drive, 1875 W Sturgeon Bay Trail, Levering, MI 49755.

Description

This trail goes through Lake Michigan sand dunes covered with oak and maple trees along with pines. It has a few steep hills. It is within Wilderness State Park, so Park rules apply. The Park marks trail intersections.

Recommended activities

Vigorous hiking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing

Sturgeon Bay Trail - There are two Sturgeon Bay Trails. One is a county road located between Pleasantview Road and Lakeshore Road. The other is a trail within Wilderness State Park.

Section #6 - 5.7 Miles

West Levering Road - Sturgeon Bay Trail

Directions

The West Levering trailhead is four and one half miles west of Pleasantview Road, at 2000 West Levering Road, Levering, MI

Description

Forests on this section of trail include mainly hardwoods. It has only a few small hills. It crosses Wycamp Dam, and one mile of the trail goes along the shore of Wycamp Lake. The section of the trail between Sturgeon Bay Trail and Wycamp Dam is within

Wilderness State Park, so Park rules apply here. Signs mark when entering/leaving the Park.

Recommended activities

Long hiking, cross country skiing and snowshoeing.

Trailhead Connector #6-#5A

Hiking south - Reverse for hiking north.

Hike south on Zmikly Road to Division Road, then west to Dzedzie Road. Property on both sides of this 1.8 mile road walk is private. **Please do not camp** along this corridor.

Section 5A - 1.85 Miles

Beckon Road to Division Road

Directions

The north end of the trail is near the corner of 2922 Division Road and Dzedzie Road. The south end of the trail is at 3940 Beckon Road east of Hill Road.

Description

This section crosses the property of the BlissFest Music Organization, following some of their trails. **Please stay on the marked trail. Do not camp.** The trail is not marked with blue blazes on trees. It is marked with blazed carsonite posts with North Country Trail and BlissFest stickers.

Note

There is a drinking water source on this property next to the trail, but operational only in summer.

Recommended Activities

Hiking, biking, cross country skiing

Trailhead Connector #5A-#5

Hiking south - Reverse for hiking north.

Hike west on Beckon Road to Rugged Road, then south on Rugged Road. At Van Road continue south on Van Road. When Van Road turns west, go straight to Section 5. Property on both sides of this 3 mile road walk is private. **Please do not camp** along this corridor.

Section #5 - 2.3 Miles

West Robinson to Van Road

Directions

The West Robinson trailhead is four and one half miles west of Pleasantview and one and six tenths of a mile east of State Road.

Description

The trail goes through hardwood forests and Red Pine plantings.

Recommended activities

Vigorous hiking and snowshoeing

Section #4 - 4.2 Miles

South Larks Lake Road To West Robinson Road

Directions

The 5498 Larks Lake trailhead is one and nine tenths of a mile northwest of Stutsmanville Road and one and four tenths of a mile south of Robinson Road. This section can be accessed on Middle Village Road, .8 mile west of Larks Lake Road, and on Palmer Road from the west.

Description

The trail has rolling hills and goes through Beech-Maple forests and Red Pine plantings

Recommended activities

Vigorous hiking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing

Section #3 - 2 Miles

Stutsmanville northwest to South Larks Lake Road

Directions

The 588 West Stutsmanville trailhead is one half mile west of Pleasantview Road.

Description

The trail is situated on wetlands with pine and aspen forests, and includes many puncheon walkways. There are beds of trillium in the spring at South Larks Lake Road.

Recommended activities

Gentle hiking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing

Trailhead Connector #2-#3

The Trailhead connector is one mile in length along Stutsmanville Road, and crosses Pleasantview Road. Water is available at the Pleasantview Town Hall.

Section #2 - 1.9 Miles

Brutus Road north to Stutsmanville Road **Directions** The 1520 E. Brutus Road trailhead is one and one half miles east of Pleasantview and seven tenths of a mile west of North Conway Road.

Description

This trail of hills, valleys, and hardwood forests crosses an active stream.

Recommended activities

Vigorous hiking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing

Section #1 - 4.85 Miles

Kipp road north to Brutus Road

Directions

Trailhead #1 is .5 mile west of North Conway Road and .5 mile north of Hathaway Road. The middle of this section can be accessed with good parking on Valley Road, 1 miles west of North Conway Road. Turn at the sign for Chestnut Valley Golf.

Description

The trail traverses high hills and deep valleys through hardwoods, cutover areas, and pine plantings.

Recommended activities

strenuous hiking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing

GPS Coordinates

GPS coordinates mark landmarks along the trail. Only two-track roads used by vehicles have been noted. Mile markers noted are small wooden signs posted on a tree and denote approximate miles within a section. Sometimes they are missing. Wilderness State Park marks their trails with intersection numbers.

- 1. Locate your entry point on the trail
- 2. Hiking south read down, top to bottom
- 3. Hiking north read up, bottom to top
