Saturday, January 6 - 10:00 a.m.

Hike Section 3 north towards Larks Lake Road - 2 miles

Meet at Pleasantview Town Hall

2982 Pleasantview Road, Harbor Springs, MI 49740

There is a parking lot at the Hall.

The trail is situated on wetlands with pine and aspen forests, and includes many puncheon walkways. There are beds of trillium in the spring at South Larks Lake Road. (GPS 45.53432, -84.91137)

Thursday,. January 25 - 8:30 p.m. Full Moon - Hike Section 1 - 1.2 miles north to Brutus Road Meet at Valley Road Parking Lot, free Warm clothing and snowshoes recommended 1000 Valley Road, Harbor Springs, MI 49740 (GPS 45.4784489, -84.8933905)

Saturday, February 3 - 10:00 a.m. Hike Section 2 south towards Brutus Road - 2 miles Meet at Stutsmanville Trailhead 400 E. Stutsmanville Road, Harbor Springs, MI 49740 Widened road parking This trail of hills, valleys, and hardwood forests crosses an active stream. (GPS 45.507822, -84.907076)

Saturday, March 2 - 10:00 a.m. Hike Section 5 north towards Van Road - 2 miles Meet at West Robinson Road Trailhead Robinson Road east of Gregory Road Side road parking difficult; Go to Gregory Road for parking The trail goes through hardwood forests and Red Pine plantings. (GPS 45.565059, -84.983102)

Saturday, April 6 - 10:00 a.m.

Hike Section 11 south towards French Farm Lake - 2.7 miles

Meet at North Central State Trailhead on Mackinaw Crossings Dr.

Near 200 S. Nicolet St., Mackinaw City, MI 49701

Free Parking lot

The trail includes views of French Farm Lake, contains many puncheon walkways and goes through hardwoods and pine forests. Part of the trail follows the Northwestern State Trail and is paved between Trails End Road and Mackinaw City. It also crosses a gas and oil pipeline.

Sunday, May 4 - 9:00 a.m.

Hike Section 7 north towards Lakeview Road - 2.8 miles

Meet at Sturgeon Bay Trail Trailhead

1875 West Sturgeon Bay Trail, Levering, MI 49755

Widened road parking

This is a very vigorous hike. The trail goes through Lake Michigan sand dunes covered with oak and maple trees along with pines. It has a few steep hills. It is within Wilderness State Park, so Park rules apply. The Park marks trail intersections. (GPS 45.679888, -84.967291)

Please Note - There are two Sturgeon Bay Trails. One is a county road which goes between Pleasantview Road and Lakeshore Road. The other is a two-track trail within Wilderness State Park.

Saturday, June 8 - 9:00 a.m.

Lady Slippers Hike - Hike section 10 north towards French Farm Lake - 5.2 miles Meet at Section 10 Trailhead

12168 Cecil Bay Road, Carp Lake, MI 49718

Side road parking

The trail includes balsam, cedar and pine forests. It crosses Carp River and French Farm Lake dam. It includes many puncheon walkways over streams and wet areas. Two miles of the trail border French Farm Lake with many scenic views and waterfowl viewing in summer. Many lady slipper flowers and other flowers are likely to be in bloom during the time of this hike.

Saturday, July 6 - 9:00 a.m.

Hike section 4 north towards Robinson Road - 4.2 miles

Meet at section 4 Trailhead

5498 South Larks Lake Road, Harbor Springs, MI 49740

Widened road parking

The trail has rolling hills and goes through Beech-Maple forests and Red Pine plantings.

Saturday, August 3 - 9:00 a.m.

Hike section 9 north towards Cecil Bay Road - 5.2 miles

Meet at Goose Pond Parking Lot

14200 Swamp Line Road, Carp Lake, MI 49718

This Parking Lot requires a Recreation Passport

The trail first follows many Wilderness Park trails with boardwalks and pine forested hills then goes through level pine forests.

Saturday, September 7 - 9:00 a.m.

Hike section 8 north towards Goose Pond - 6.5 miles

Meet at Lakeview Road Parking lot

10498 N. Lake Shore Drive, Carp Lake, MI 49718

Parking Lot with Recreation Passport required

About half of this trail goes through pine and hardwood forests, a swamp, through Lake Michigan forested sand dunes and along many ponds. The other half of this trail follows Wilderness Park Trails, Sturgeon Bay Trail, and Swampline. Wilderness Park marks trail intersections. All of this section is within Wilderness State Park, and Park rules apply.

Note: There are two Sturgeon Bay Trails. One is a county road which goes between Pleasantview Road and North Lakeshore Drive. The other is a trail within Wilderness State Park.

Saturday, October 12 - 10:00 a.m.

Hike section 6 north towards Sturgeon Bay Trail - 5.7 miles

Meet at Levering Road trailhead

2000 West Levering Road, Levering, MI 49755

Corner of Zmikly Road and Levering Road

Parking along Zmikly Road

The trail goes through hardwoods, crosses Wycamp Dam, enters Wilderness State Park, goes along the edge of Wycamp Lake, and then through pine and hardwoods forest.

Saturday, November 2 - 10:00 a.m.

Hike section 5A south towards Beckon Road - 1.5 miles

Meet at Division and Dzedzie Road intersection

2922 Division Road, Pellston, MI 49769

Side road parking on Dzedzie Road

This section crosses the property of the BlissFest Music Organization, following some of their trails. The trail is not marked with blue blazes on trees. It is marked with blazed carsonite posts with North Country Trail and BlissFest stickers.

Saturday, December 7 - 10:00 a.m.

Hike Section 1 south towards Valley Road - 3.6 miles

Meet at Kipp Road Trailhead

7600 Kipp Road, Conway, MI 49722

Side road parking

The trail traverses high hills and deep valleys through hardwoods, cutover areas, and pine plantings.
