Or better yet, if you want the GPS reading for anywhere on the PWC, go to the [online NCTA here](#): click on the ruler in the legend at the top left of that map, then click on the compass in the legend at the top right that pops up and you will see the Latitude and Longitude in that legend box for anywhere you put your cursor on that map.
