Getting to North Dakota:

- Driving: Interstate 94 links the Twin Cities, Minnesota to Fargo and Bismarck. You'll cross the NCT in Fergus Falls, MN and can stop and stretch your legs on it at the Prairie Wetlands Learning Center.
- Flying: Airports with rental car facilities are available in Fargo, Bismarck, and Minot. The larger Twin Cities airport (MSP) is approximately 250 miles/3.5-hour drive from Fargo via I-94.
- Amtrak: the Empire Builder arrives daily at Fargo, Devil's Lake, and Minot but is often late. Learn more at https://www.amtrak.com/empire-builder-train. Note: there is no car rental available at the Fargo train station but they are available elsewhere in Fargo-Moorhead.

Wednesday, August 20th - gather in the Sheyenne National Grassland area in the morning and afternoon for hikes on the Dakota Prairie Chapter trail segment. Evening events will be held nearby in the Sheyenne National Grasslands, located about 40 miles southwest of Fargo / 30 miles east of Lisbon.



An afternoon hike will be available from the Garrison Dam National Fish Hatchery to the Western Terminus. An outdoor picnic and short program in Lake Sakakawea State Park will wrap up our adventure.
